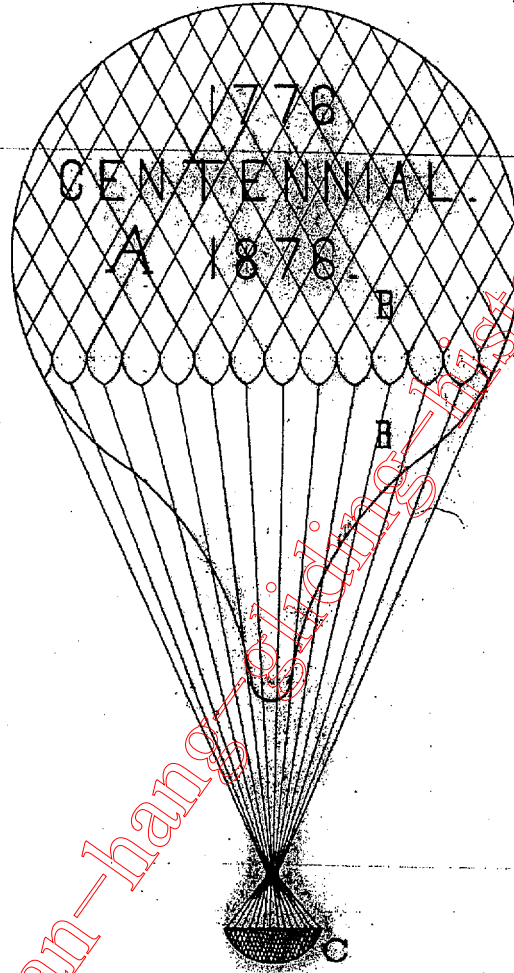

SAMUEL M. SIMONS, OF PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA.

DESIGN FOR KITE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **6,961**, dated October 14, 1873; application filed September 15, 1873.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL M. SIMONS, of Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for Kites, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

My design for a kite consists in forming it to resemble a balloon, as shown, A in the drawing representing the balloon proper, B the netting, and C the basket. The word and dates (Centennial, 1776, 1876) shown, or any

others, may be printed on the balloon, at discretion; or they may be omitted altogether, as such form no part of my design. The design can be printed in any desired colors.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a kite, substantially as shown and described.
